AMS is closely monitoring reports and remain committed to helping address concerns as we adjust to updated guidance on controlling the spread of the virus.

The well-being of providers, patients, contractors and employees is our top priority. We recommend that you monitor the websites of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) as well as local and state health departments for the latest guidance and information.

To address your concerns, AMS is taking significant precautionary steps that include:

- Monitoring updates on local, state, and federal health-care related websites
- Asking providers to let us know of any impacts that they are facing
- Asking AMS employees and contractors to self-monitor their health and not accept any assignments if they are ill
- Limiting the number of Clinical Specialists assigned to patient in-home visits
- Requiring all AMS Clinical Specialist to wear CDC approved personal protective equipment (PPE), which include non-sterile disposable patient gloves and respirators when setting-up a patient
- Stressing CDC personal hygiene best practices which include; frequent and effective hand washing and restricted social interaction (such as handshaking)
